Jos Zegers, (1983) started his musical career on oboe at the age of eight. In 2001, besides studying Business Economics at Maastricht University, he started his study oboe at the Maastricht conservatory. In 2006 he graduated cum laude with Hans Roerade (Residentie Orchestra, The Hague). One year earlier he was soloist during the Korea festival of the Maastricht Conservatory, conducted by Jan Stulen.

In 2011 he graduated cum laude in Conducting at the Royal Conservatory in The Hague. He also took various master classes and took lessons with, among others, Josef Suilen and Jan Cober.

Since 2007 he has been an active conductor with various orchestras. As the youngest participant, he reached the semi-finals of the international conductor competition of the WMC Kerkrade, The Netherlands in 2009 and in 2010 the semifinal the international conductor competition "Con Brio" in Innsbruck, Austria, again as the youngest participant.

In 2015 he won the latter contest. He worked with various internationally renowned soloists. Since 2016 he has been conductor of the Bundespolizei Orchester München, a 46-person professional orchestra. In February 2019 he makes his debut as guest conductor with the Münchener Symphoniker.
